Apartment Safety and Security at Bath Housing Properties

Some information and reminders about personal safety, securing your apartment, and protecting personal property:

- Each residents is responsible for the security of their own apartment.
- Remember to always lock your door when you are out of your apartment.
- Keep track of all of your keys.
- If you find that items have been stolen from your apartment call the Bath Police Department to report the theft.
- If your medications have been stolen, contact your doctor's office right away. Most insurances will replace stolen prescriptions.
- To help ensure apartment security, the locks used in Bath Housing buildings can not be opened using a credit card.
- Make sure that your Renters Insurance policy in up to date.

COVID-19 Precautions
