Bath Housing residents now have a free and easy way to get out to pick up food, medications, and to get to medical appointments in the Bath/Brunswick area.

The free ride program is made possible through funding from the Davenport Trust and Bath Housing. Transportation is provided by Tee’s Taxi.

Over the past two weeks 22 residents have used the service to get to their doctor or dentist, and for trips to Shaw’s, Brackett’s, and Walmart for groceries.

Residents of Anchorage, Seacliff, Dikes Landing, and Moorings are encouraged to use the Free Ride Program for your next trip!
