Tedford Housing Homeless Prevention and Outreach

Tedford works with households who have received eviction notices, are doubled up, or are at risk of becoming homeless. Assistance with security deposits and past due rent are available for qualified applicants. People experiencing literal homelessness can be referred to emergency shelters and assisted housing applications, rental vouchers and other resources.
